II) ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:

For MD/MS/M.Ch (6 years)/MDS Courses :

i) MBBS/BDS degree of a University recognised by the MCI/DCI. ii) 55% aggregate marks in all MBBS/BDS professional examinations (50% in the case of candidates belonging to SCs/STs). iii) Must have completed the required period of 12 months pre-registration internship from a recognized hospital on or before 30th January, 2008.

Candidates who have already done/are pursuing MD/MS/MDS in any subject at the time of counselling are not eligible for MD/MS/MDS courses.

2. (A) For DM/M.Ch. Courses: Must possess a degree of (a) M.D. in Medicine for D.M. in Cardiology, Endocrinology, Nephrology, Gastroenterology, Neurology (b) M.D. in Pathology for D.M. in Haemato-Pathology (c) M.D. in Medicine/Paediatrics for D.M. in Medical Oncology & Clinical Haematology (d) M.D. in Radio-diagnosis for D.M. in Neuro-Radiology (e) M.D. in Anaesthesiology for D.M. in Cardiac-Anaesthesiology and Neuro-Anaesthesiology (f) M.D. in Paediatrics for D.M. in Neonatology and D.M. in Paediatric Neurology, and (g) M.S. in Surgery for M.Ch. courses of this Institute or any other University recognised by the MCI for this purpose. (B) For Senior Residency (Super Speciality): The entrance examination for Sr. Residency seats in super speciality departments will be held alongwith DM/M.Ch. candidates and the seats thus will be filled up as per Govt. of India Residency Scheme. The said seats will be available between the period from 01.01.2008 to 30.06.2008 and will be given on 6 monthly adhoc basis extendible upto three years. If the seat of Sr. Resident in the super-speciality is converted to that of DM/M.Ch. seat, the same will be advertised for fresh selection after completion of tenure period. The eligibility criteria for the Senior Residency (Super Speciality) posts will be same as for DM/M.Ch. (Academic Seats).

2008 relaxable in case of SC/ST candidates by a maximum of 5 yrs. (There is no upper age limit for sponsored candidates). For Senior Residency (Super Speciality): 33 years, relaxation for SC/ST candidate upto a maximum of 5 years, in case of OBC candidate upto a maximum of 3 years. 3. For Master in Hospital Administration (M.H.A.): Eligibility: For medical graduates: MBBS or an equivalent degree with not less than 55% aggregate marks with 3 years experience in a recognised hospital or 5 years experience in general practice. For non-medical graduates (eligible for sponsored seats only): (a) Bachelor's degree of a recognised University in Arts or Science or Nursing or Business Administration or Commerce or Engineering or any technical subject with at least 60% marks. (b) 7 years experience in a responsible administrative position.

Upper Age Limit: For DM/M.Ch. Courses: 35 years as on 1st January,

4. For Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.): A degree of M.Sc. or Master's degree in any subject allied to Bio Medical Sciences or Master's degree in Nursing with at least 60% marks, or MD/MS or an equivalent degree or Diplomate of the National Board of Examinations or MBBS degree with not less than 55% aggregate marks.

Central/State sponsored/foreign national candidates are also required to fill in the prescribed application form. 2. A candidate can submit only one application for DM / M.Ch. & Ph.D. Courses.

IMPORTANT: 1. Candidates must obtain application forms ONLY from an authorised branch of S.B.I. or by post from Examination Section of AIIMS. Forms obtained from an unauthorized source will be rejected. 2. Candidates are advised to procure blank application forms as early as possible instead of waiting for the last date.
