UCSF/ARI George Sarlo award for excellence in mentoring. In 2002, he was chosen as the 45th Faculty Research Lecturer at the University, the highest honor given to a member of the Academic Senate. In 2004, he received the Abbott Laboratories Award for outstanding research in immunology. In 2008, he was awarded the Gold Medal for excellence in medical research by Columbia University College of Physicians and Surgeons. Dr. Levy is the Editor-in-Chief of the highly-cited journal AIDS. He has published over 600 scientific articles and reviews and is the author or editor of fourteen books dealing with viruses and immunology. Among these are his acclaimed four volume series, *The Retroviridae* and his seminal, sole-authored book, *HIV and the Pathogenesis of AIDS*, now in its third edition (2007) and translated into several languages. Dr. Levy participates in programs of the World Affairs Council and the Council on Foreign Relations. He is an AIDS advisor in several countries (e.g. India, China, Mexico, Ethiopia, the Dominican Republic, Thailand).
