

#### Dates:


- 1 Announcement and call for nominations : 12<sup>th</sup> December, 2019 (Thursday)
- 2 Last date of submitting nominations : 21<sup>st</sup> December, 2019 (Saturday)
- 3 Last date of withdrawal of nominations : 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2020 (Wednesday)
- 4 Declaration of names: Contestants : 2<sup>nd</sup> January, 2020 (Thursday)
- 5 Date of election : 14<sup>th</sup> January, 2020 (Tuesday)
- 6 Date of declaration of results : 17<sup>th</sup> January, 2020 (Friday)

#### Guidelines:
