## **OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

Sub: Mosquitoes in Patient Care area & Offices reg.

During the rounds of the undersigned, it has been noted that there are mosquitoes present in various patient care areas & offices. This is a grave threat to patients, their attendants & staff alike as the mosquitoes can lead to further transmission of diseases like Dengue, Malaria, etc. from/to community as well as from patients admitted with similar vector borne diseases.

To control the menace of mosquitoes, engineering services department is required to take all possible measures including but not limited to:

- Mosquito mesh shall be installed in all central air conditioning vents
- All doors shall be automatic opening & closing with access control except fire doors
- Air curtains shall be installed at all frequently used doors
- Windows fitted with non-toughened glass shall be screwed close in patient care areas
- Electric Mosquito catchers & repellents shall be installed in all areas
