Contingency plan for Hospital Patient Care Services in AIIMS Hospital & all centres view of one day strike by the Resident Doctors Association on 14.06.2019.

In view of proposed one day strike by the Resident doctors on 14.06.2019, communicated by RDA vide their letter no. nil dated 13.06.2019 (Protest and strike against violence in West Bengal) addressed to the Director AIIMS, following contingency plan will be followed for Hospital patient care services in AIIMS Hospital and all Centres:

1. Emergency Services – Emergency services will function normally as the resident doctors will purportedly continue to work in the emergency services as per their scheduled duties.

However requisite consultation(s) for the emergency patients will be provided by the faculty-on-call of concerned clinical departments supported by sponsored resident doctors / resident doctors willing to work / research medical staff of concerned speciality department. Head(s) of concerned speciality department will draw up appropriate plan/duty roster for the same to ensure timely consultation & requisite treatment to emergency patients.

- 2. OPD services OPD services will function on a restricted basis on 14.06.2019 till such time that normalcy is restored. Only follow-up patients with prior appointment will be registered in the OPD's. OPD registration of new patients will be restricted and will be done as per availability of faculty in the respective OPD as decided by Head of concerned deptt./unit/faculty. No walk-in registration for OPD patients (new & old) will be done.
- 3. Inpatient wards services Inpatient (General & Private) wards patient care services will continue to function as per discretion of concerned clinical department/unit. Head(s) of all clinical departments/units will make requisite arrangements for round the clock availability of doctors of concerned speciality (faculty-on-call supported by sponsored resident doctors / resident doctors willing to work / research medical staff of concerned speciality department). Under no circumstances, any inpatient ward will function without physical availability of doctors of concerned speciality.

- 4. Inpatient ICU Services Inpatient ICU patient care services in various ICU's of the institute will function normally as the resident doctors will purportedly continue to work in the ICU's as per their scheduled duties.
 - Requisite cover & consultation / cross consultation for the ICU patients will be provided by the faculty-on-call of concerned clinical departments supported by sponsored resident doctors / resident doctors willing to work / research medical staff of concerned speciality department.
- 5. Labour Room & Maternity OT will remain functional and will be managed by the faculty-on-call of Obs. & Gynae supported by sponsored resident doctors / resident doctors willing to work / research medical staff of concerned speciality department.
- 6. Operation Theatre Services Routine OT services will largely remain suspended on 14.06.2019. However some specific cases may be taken up for surgery as per feasibility & mutual agreement between concerned faculty of surgery & anaesthesiology. Emergency cases will be taken up for surgical operations as per requirement.
- 7. Diagnostic Services Radio-diagosis & Lab. diagnosis services will function on a restricted basis, to the maximum extent as feasible, by the faculty of concerned department(s) supported by sponsored resident doctors / resident doctors willing to work / research medical staff of concerned speciality department.
- 8. Support Services will function normally and will be supervised/managed by concerned faculty of Hospital Administration supported by sponsored resident doctors / resident doctors willing to work.
