NDDTC SPECIALITY CLINIC: CONSULTATION LIAISON ADDICTION PSYCHIATRY

National Drug Dependence Treatment Centre (NDDTC) is running a speciality service - Consultation Liaison Addiction Psychiatry in psychiatry OPD as well as different wards in AIIMS. Patients presenting in various medical and surgical disciplines with comorbid substance use disorder (SUD)/addiction and requiring treatment for SUD will be seen by a team of NDDTC faculty and Senior Residents.
