Subject: Precautionary measures against dengue fever, regarding

 The increased risk of vector borne diseases like dengue and malaria, transmission needs no emphasis.

With the onset of monsoon, it is imperative that all possible precautions and preventive measures be taken to prevent creation/sustenance of breeding sites in the hospital premises.

To achieve the above mentioned objective the following Engineering and Sanitation measures need to be reinforced:

(b) All drains are operational, covered and clean

(c) Adequate drainage provision for water from window AC should be made.

(d) Water cooler Maintenance i.e. water be changed at regular intervals and dry day to be observed strictly.

(e) Empty packing material and also malba of engineering construction at various sites be removed immediately the sites be cleaned off debris.

Sanitation and cleanliness of area in and around the hospital to be ensured meticulously.

(iii) Timely and appropriate spraying of in insecticide/larvicide to be ensured by regular monitoring by supervisors and area in-charges.
