TENDER CORRIGENDUM

The Tender No.63/CNC/CTVS/24-25/ST. with tender ID:2024_AIMSD_827500_1 was published in CPP Portal (e-Procurement) on date:24/09/2024 for the purchase of **Cell Saver for Intra-operative Blood Salvage (Cell Saver)-03 Nos.** for the department of CTVS, CNC, AIIMS, NEW DELHI. In response to the published bid, two bidders (i.e. M/s. Genesee Medical and M/s. J Mitra & Sons) submitted their representations and requested for amendment in the published specifications. Upon the request of the potential vendors & recommendations of TSEC, few amendments have been carried out in the published specifications. The bid submission end date and Opening date are also being extended as under:

Sr. No.	Item's Name: Cell Saver for Intra-Operative Blood Salvage (Cell Saver)
1.	System should be capable of processing blood collected from a surgical site to produce washed red blood cell to return to patient later on.
2.	System should work on centrifuge principle and should operate on 1000-2500 rpm with variable speed wash.
3.	System should have a smaller foot print with big lockable castor wheel and weight should be less than 90Kg (inclusive of accessories and cart) for ease of mobility.
4.	System should be fully automated with simple operation and absolutely minimal user intervention.
5.	The system has an in-built and regulated vacuum suction.
6.	Centrifugal bowl capacity should be 125-230 ml with two stage filling cycle or equivalent technology.
7.	The system has variable speed pulse wash cycle.
8.	System should be approved by US FDA/CE for autologous blood transfusion.

10.	Should be able to continue the procedure and maintain data even in case of power failure.
11.	A built in barcode reader to record disposable set, solutions and operator/patients information.
12.	The ability to download data using a USB flash drive.
13.	A color touch screen display.
14.	The noise level of the device should be < 70 db.
15.	Device should have effluent line sensor, reservoir level sensor and automatic bowl identification program.
16.	RBC recovery should be more than 90%.
17.	The device should have post-operative mode to work even after surgery by collecting the blood from the disposable tubing placed in the wound.
18.	Completely automated postoperative operation.
19.	The device generates the suction in the reservoir.



20.	The device begins the processing cycles when an appropriate amount of blood solution collects in the reservoir.

Important Conditions:

- The bidder must quote rates of equipment with 05 (five) years onsite Comprehensive warranty (Including all spares, accessories, batteries, 3rd party items and labor) from the date of Installation of equipment. Further bidder must quote rates of Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract (CAMC) Including all spares, accessories, batteries, 3rd party items and labor) for 6th to 10th years, after expiry of five years comprehensive warranty. In case, bidder not quoted rates for CMAC, it will be treated included and must be provide 10 years comprehensive warranty within quoted rates of equipment. No CAMC proposal will be considered later on. **The cost of equipment + CAMC (NPV) charges inclusive of GST + Consumables (mentioned below), will be considered for ranking (L-1) purpose.**
- All software updates till the period of 5 years to be provided free of cost.

The parent company should give the undertaking to provide the spares for 10 years, if required.

Original Manufacturer or their subsidiary or authorized dealer who is quoting should be present in India having selling experience of more than 02 years in government institutes/hospitals.

In no case the instrument should remain in non-working condition for more than 24 hours, beyond which a penalty as per the rules of the institute will be levied.

32.

The vendor should have a good service and application back up along with instruments to provide an effective trouble shooting and support. (Response time <12 hours).

33.

There should be service backup readily available within city and any complaint of malfunction should be attended to within 24 hours.

It will be responsibility of the vendor to submit proposal of CAMC at least 6 months before expiry of warranty of previous CAMC.
