





1.	Meniscus Clamp Low-profile design to facilitate grasping the posterior portion of the meniscus in open knee surgery. Total Length: 17-18 cm. ; Teeth Length: 2 mm.; Jaw Length: 35-40 mm.	Two Nos.
2.	Cement remover Helps remove unhardened cement around femoral and tibial knee components Designed with sharper faces to help remove unhardened cement around femoral and tibial knee components. The remover is nitrate coated to help protect implant surfaces. Overall Length: 6-8";Handle Length: 3-5";Blade Width: 5-7mm	Two Nos.
3.	PCL Protector in TKR Designed to help protect the posterior cruciate ligament in cruciate retaining total knee surgery during the proximal tibial cut. It should be curved distally so that it can put over the PCL from the top/posterior side and with a few taps, the fanned blade can get around the PCL and into the bone (not more than 5 mm) and "cover" the PCL. Overall Length: 20-22 cms	Two Nos.
4.	Offset Osteotome Designed to remove osteophytes from the posterior femoral condyles during knee arthroplasty. Blade Width: 15-20 mm Overall Length: 9-10"	Four Nos.
5.	Tibial Angle measurement device Designed to be placed on the cutting block to check if the cut is level. It should have Two magnets in the base help to hold it in place upon a cutting block. It should be autoclavable. Dimensions of the device: 5-6 c.m.x7-8 c.m	One No.
6.	Pin Extractor The Pin Extractor should be completely cannulated. The grasping end should be contoured to not block the surgeon's field of view. The handle should be shaped so not to slide in the surgeon's hand and for better leverage. It should also have threads on the handle to allow use of a slap hammer which can be screwed into a threaded pin inserter/ extractor to help in removing pins in hard bone. It should be suitable for 3.2 mm pins.	One No.

7.	Pin driver Designed to hold onto a 1/8" diameter pin while it is being inserted into a cutting block during total knee surgery or other applications where a 1/8" diameter pin is used. The end of pin inserter should have a feature to be attached to a drill.	One No.
8.	Retractors for knee replacement	
a)	PCL Retractor Designed to straddle the cruciate ligament and lie in the femoral condylar notch, allowing the surgeon to retract the tibia away from the femur for better access. The handle is contoured away from the surgeon's field of view. Total Length: 25-26 c.m. Prong Width: 5- 5.5 m.m. Gap between the prongs: 10 mm	Two Nos.
b)	Z knee retractor Designed to expose the femur and the tibia during knee surgery for better access to the articulating surfaces. The "Z" contouring of the retractor should provide the surgeon with an open field of view and working area. Overall Total length 18-19 c.m. Width of Blades: 10.5-12 mm Depth of Blade: 7-8 cm	Two Nos.
c)	45° knee retractor Retractor with 45 degree angle for use in knee surgery for anterior tibial retraction, length of 20-25 cms	Two Nos.
d)	Anterior Tibial Retractor Used for anterior translation of tibia in Knee replacement. Length 9-10" and blade width above tip of 14-15 mm	Two Nos.




