JUSTIFICATION FOR PURCHASE OF PSSCogREHAB

The primary objective of this project is to examine the effects of a manual cognitive training kit (AIIMS CTT) and computer-based cognitive training kits (PSSCogRehab and CogMED) in improving the neuro-psycho-physiological functioning in children aged 6-11 years diagnosed with ADHD. The use of computer-based cognitive training and neuro-feedback as treatments of attention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder (ADHD) has been few recent advances in the treatment of ADHD. However, a computer based intervention such as PSS CogRehab or CogMED may not be plausible solutions for a resource-limited country like India, where out-patient departments/clinics are not even having computer desktops. Therefore, a methodologically sound manual cognitive training kit was felt as the need of the hour for a heavily demanded hospital outpatient child guidance clinic to cater to specific cognitive needs of the children with ADHD. AIIMS cognitive training toolkit (AIIMS CTT) was a product to fill in this gap in clinical practice in India. Thus, in order to establish the same, we need to purchase PSSCogRehab so that all the three treatment modalities may be administered on the patients and compared with each other.
