SECTION-II

In this tender the following words (s), unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, shall have the meaning (s) assigned to them herein below:

“Deadline for Submission of Bids” shall mean the last date and time for receipt of Bids as set-forth in this tender document or such other date/time as may be decided by All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi in its sole discretion and notified to the bidders by dissemination of requisite information in this regard.

“Bid Process” means the process of selection of the successful bidder through competitive bidding and includes submission of bids, scrutiny and evaluation of such bids as set forth in the tender document.

“Letter of acceptance ”shall mean the purchaser will inform to the bidder who qualifies the Technical & Financial bid stage of this Tender

SECTION III

TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR SUBMITTING TENDER FOR SUPPLY OF NEW AMBULANCE DIESEL ENGINE MEETING BS-IV EMISSION NORMS.

1- GENERAL

1.1-National Drug Dependence Treatment Centre, All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi invites Tender from manufacturers or their authorized dealers/ Stockiest authorized by the manufacturer to quote on their behalf for this tender for purchases of 01 (One) Ambulance propelled by Diesel engine, Conforming to BS-IV emission norms as per technical specifications attached herewith on section –IV.

2.1-Complete bid in the prescribed format should be submitted on or before the time and date fixed for submission of bid. The tenderer along with its quotations must also submit a certified copy of its latest income Tax clearance certificate and other documents related to registration of firms

2.3 Brokers and middlemen are not eligible for participation in the bid in any way.

2-ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Only diesel engine ambulance manufacturers or their authorized dealers/ Stockiest authorized by the manufacturer to quote on their behalf, shall be eligible to participate

3-COST OF DOCUMENT

The tender documents can be downloaded from the official **website** www.aiims.ac.in, www.aiims.edu. The tender documents can be downloaded free of cost, however, the tender fee of Rs- 500/- (Rs. Five hundred only) (non-refundable) against the tender documents, has to be paid by the bidder in the form of Demand Draft, payable to ‘Account Officer, NDDTC, AIIMS, New Delhi with the bid. _

4-DOCUMENTS / ITEMS COMPRISING THE BID

The proposal shall be submitted by the Bidder in two Bids viz. Technical Bid and Financial Bid.

4.1-Technical bid shall be submitted along with EMD and all other documents as well technical and commercial information required in accordance with the Tender document.

4.2-Financial Bid shall consist of only Price Schedule in the prescribed formats as per section-VI

5-TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

4.1-The Air conditioned diesel engine ambulance requires against this bid shall conform to the Technical Specifications of the Tender Document. **(Refer Section-IV).** The bidder has to clarify in the each parameter of the specifications about its product, whether the offered model / product is meeting out

the requisite specifications or not. If not, meeting out the requisite specifications, the bidder has to indicate their specification of that parameter.

4.2- The diesel engine ambulance shall comply with the requirements of Centre Motor Vehicle (Amendments) Rules 2015, as amended time to time and Utter Pradesh Motor Vehicle rules (UPMVR). **CONFIRMITY TO GSR 287(E), and vehicle BODY CODE AIS-052(With all amendments till date)**

The model of diesel engine ambulance shall be approved by the department of transport ,Utter Pradesh for registering the Ambulance in Ghaziabad, Utter Pradesh (UP).

4.3- The Bidder must submit a certified copy of the approval of diesel engine ambulance by department of transport ,Utter Pradesh for registering the Ambulance in RTO Ghaziabad (UP).

6-EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD)

6.1-The Bidder shall furnish “Earnest Money Deposit” (EMD) of Rs. 40,000/ (Rs. Forty thousand only), w.r.t bid diesel engine ambulance as part of his Bid. The EMD shall be sealed in a separate sealed envelope super scribed “Earnest Money Deposit ‘ for Bid due on ----- -- upto -----hours for diesel engine ambulance to be deposited. The Earnest Money Demand (EMD) should be in the form of ‘ Account payee Demand Draft’ payable in favor of “Account Officer, NDDTC, AIIMS, New Delhi payable New Delhi.

6.2-Any Bid not accompanied with valid Bid Security / EMD in the acceptable form will be –liable to be rejected by the Purchaser considering it as non-responsive.

6.3- No interest will be payable by the Purchaser on the bid security.

6.4- The EMD is liable to be forfeited if the Bidder withdraws amends, impairs, or derogates from the bid in any respect within the period of validity of its bid.

6.5 –The decision of Purchaser in this respect shall be final and binding.

7-DISCHARGE OF EMD OF UNSUCCESSFUL BIDDERS(S)

The EMD of unsuccessful Bidders will be discharged / returned as promptly as possible after the expiry of the Bid validity period and / or within 30 days from the date of signing the agreement with the successful bidder.

8-DISCHARGE OF EMD OF SUCCESSFUL BIDDER(S)

8.1-The bid security of the Successful Bidder(s) shall be discharged only after the successful bidder(s) furnishes the Contract Performance Security as required.

8.2-If the successful Bidder(s) fails to furnish the Contract Performance, Security within the requisite period as specified in the ‘General Conditions of Contract’, then the bid Security shall be liable to be forfeited by the Purchaser, in addition to any other actions as per terms and conditions

9-PRICE

9-1 financial bid/proposal should be as per the format. **(Section-VI).**

9-2-The price for the diesel engine ambulance shall include a complete break-up showing the basic price, excise duty, other levies, sales tax, forwarding charges, freight and insurance charges and other charges, if any, shall also be given. Government levies / duties / taxes on the ambulance as applicable on the date of opening of price bids will be considered for evaluation.

9.3- In case there is variation in the statutory levies / taxes during the period of the contract, the same will be payable at actual to the bidder subject to the delivery is arranged within the agreed delivery schedule.

9.4-The price quoted shall be firm and not subject to any upward variation except for the variation in statutory levies & duties.

10.-TRANSIT INSURANCE

Transit insurance of the ambulance will be got done by the firm and is to be included in the offered rates.

11- BID VALIDITY

11.1-The bid shall remain valid for a period of 180 days from the specified date of bid opening of financial bid.

11.2-In exceptional circumstances prior to expiry of the original bid validity period, the Purchaser may request the Bidder for extension in the period of validity. A Bidder may refuse the request without becoming liable for forfeiture of EMD. However, this bid may be rejected by the Purchaser on such refusal.

12-TWO BID SYSTEM

12.1-Technical bid of the Performa of shall consist submission of Bid with EMD, Performance Statement, technical details and all other documents as well as the technical and commercial information required in accordance with the tender document.

12.2-Financial Bid shall contain only the price schedule in the prescribed format, as per **Section-VI (Ambulance)** of the Tender document.

13-MODIFICATION, AND WITHDRAWAL OF BIDS

The Bidder has the discretion to modify or withdraw his bid after submission, but before the last date and time fixed for submission of the bids.

14-BID OPENING

The Technical Bids of all the Bidders will be opened by the Purchaser at time, date and place

indicated in the Bid Documents. In the event of the specified date of bid opening being declared a holiday for the Purchaser, the bids shall be opened at the same time and location on the next working day

15-CLARIFICATION OF BID

To assist in the examination, evaluation and comparison of Bids, the Purchaser may, if necessary, ask the Bidders individually for clarification of their bids, including break-up of prices.

16-DETERMINATION OF RESPONSIVENESS

16.1-The Purchaser will determine whether each bid is responsive to the requirements of the bid documents. A responsive bid is one which conforms to all the terms & conditions and specifications of the Bid Documents without any material deviation or reservation.

16.2-The bidder shall have to clearly specify the deviation, if any. "Deviation" may include exceptions exclusions, qualifications, conditions, stated assumptions and alternative proposals not solicited.

16.3.A material deviation or reservation is one which effects in any way the scope, quality, performance or administration of the contract by the Bidder, or which limits in any way, inconsistent with the Bid Documents the purchase rights or the Bidder's obligations under the contract, and the rectification of which would affect unfairly the competitive position of other Bidders presenting responsive Bids at reasonable prices.

16.4-If a Bid is not responsive to the requirements of the Bid Documents it will be liable to be rejected by the Purchaser. The decision of the Purchaser in this respect will be final and binding on the bidder.

17-EVALUATION AND COMPARISON OF BIDS

17.1-The Purchaser will evaluate and compare only those Bids determined to be responsive to the requirements of the Bid Document. The Bidders are required to provide all technical details, as these are required for evaluation purpose as per this tender document. Bids received without full & complete specification are liable to be rejected.

17.2The Purchaser shall go through and evaluate the Technical bids and advise accordingly only those Bidders whose bids shall be found responsive to the requirements of the Bid Document, financial Bids of only such Bidders will be opened at the time & date to be notified later to individual successful Bidders (successful in technical bid).

17.3-The price/financial bids of other Bidders, who do not qualify as a result of Technical evaluation, shall not be opened. The Purchaser shall evaluate and compare the price/financial bids of only those Bidders who have offered the prices complete in all respect as per the tender document.

18-AWARD OF CONTRACT: AWARD CRITERIA

Subject to the above, the Purchaser will consider the Bidder whose Bid has been determined to be responsive, complete and in accordance with the tender document and whose offer on evaluation has been determined to be the lowest acceptable offer.

19-PURCHASER RIGHT TO ACCEPT ANY BID AND TO REJECT ANY OR ALL BIDS

The Purchaser reserves the right to accept or reject any Bid, and to annul the Bid Process and reject all Bids without assigning any reason.

20-NOTIFICATION OF AWARD

Prior to the expiry of the period of Bid validity, the Purchaser will notify the successful Bidder through fax / mail to confirm in writing by Registered/Speed Post as well online that his Bid has been accepted. This letter hereinafter and in the General Conditions of Contract called '**Letter of Acceptance**

21-SIGNING AND ACCEPTANCE OF LETTER OF ACCEPTANCE

Upon receipt of the **Letter of Acceptance** the successful Bidder shall return two copies of the Letter of Acceptance duly signed and stamped by his authorized signatory within 14 days from the date of receipt of Letter of Acceptance. However, the Contract shall be deemed to be concluded on the date of dispatch of the 'Letter of Acceptance' by the Purchaser. Upon return of '**Letter of Acceptance** from the successful Bidder, Contract in accordance with the Tender Document, shall have to be signed by both the parties._

22-PERFORMANCE SECURITY

22.1-The Contractor/Bidder shall furnish Performance security en-cashable at New Delhi in the shape of a Bank Guarantee in the Performa prescribed in the tender document alongwith the acceptance of supply order, for an amount equivalent to 10% of the value of the contract as per section VI in Indian Rupees.

22.2-The Purchaser shall be entitled and it shall be lawful on his part to forfeit the amount of the Performance security in whole or in part in the event of any default, failure or neglect on the part of the Bidder in the fulfillment or performance in any manner whatsoever of the contract under reference or any other contract with the Purchaser or any part thereof to the satisfaction of the Purchaser.

22.3The Performance, Security Deposit submitted by the supplier will remain valid at least for 60 days beyond the guarantee/warranty period.

23-CONTRACT

The contract shall be for the supply of diesel engine ambulance of the descriptive specifications and in the quantities set forth in the document. The whole contract is to be executed in the approved, substantial and workman like manner, to the entire satisfaction of the Purchaser.

24- DELAY PENALTY

Any delay on the part of the firm for supplying the ambulance after the scheduled delivery period will attract a delay penalty @ 2% of the value of delayed supply per month of delay or part thereof. However, the maximum delay penalty will be limited to 10% value of delayed supply of ambulance.

25-TERMINATION OF CONTRACT

The Purchaser may, without prejudice to any other remedy for any breach of any terms /condition of the contract, by written notice of default of **15 days** sent to the Contractor/Bidder, terminate the contract –

I-If the Contractor/Bidder fails to deliver the ambulance within the delivery schedule (s) specified in the contract, or any extension thereof granted by the Purchaser.

II-If the Contractor/Bidder fails to perform any other obligation (s) under the contract.

26-DELIVERY OF AIR CONDITIONED DIESEL ENGINE AMBULANCE

26.1-The delivery of Air Conditioned diesel engine ambulance BS –IV is to be completed within the contracted delivery schedule of 30 days (one month) from the date of issue of confirm supply/Purchase Order. If the Contractor/Bidder fails to complete the supplies within contracted delivery period of 30 days, the Purchaser shall take actions as per General Conditions of Contract.

26.2- **The Contractor/Bidder shall, as may be required by the Purchaser, deliver at the place detailed in the purchase order.**

26.3-The ambulance shall be delivered not later than the dates specified in the contract/purchase order otherwise penalties would be imposed as per penalty clause.

26.4- The Purchaser shall not be liable to render assistance to the Contractor/bidder in securing or in arranging or providing transport for the ordered diesel engine ambulance.

26.5-The time allowed for and the date specified in the contract or as extended, for the delivery of the diesel engine ambulance shall be the essence of the contract and delivery must be completed no later than the date (s) so specified or extended.

26.6 A failure or delay by the Contractor/Bidder in the performance of his obligations for delivery of Diesel Engine Ambulance, the Purchaser at his discretion may take any one or all of the following actions :

- a) Terminate the Contract for unsupplied quantity, and/or
- b) Forfeit the Performance Guarantee: and/or

- c) Extend the delivery period for the unsupplied quantity with imposition of pre Estimated liquidated damages.

26.7-If at any time during performance of the Contract, the Contractor/Bidder should encounter conditions beyond his control impeding timely delivery of the diesel engine ambulance, the Contractor/Bidder shall promptly notify the Purchaser in writing of the fact of the delay, its likely duration and its cause(s). As soon as practicable after receipt of the Contractor's notice, the Purchaser may evaluate the situation and may, at his discretion, extend the Contractor's time for performance, in which case, the extension shall be ratified by the parties by amendment of the Contract. The extension so granted if any, shall not levy any penalty as specified in the aforesaid clauses.

27-SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTE AND ARBITRATION-

27.1-Amicable Resolution

(A) Save where expressly stated otherwise in this Contract, any dispute, difference or controversy of whatever nature howsoever arising under, out of or in relation to this Contract between the Parties and so notified in writing by either Party to the other (the "Dispute") in the first instance shall be attempted to be resolved amicably by the Parties and failing such the same shall be resolved in accordance with the procedure set forth here below.

(B) Either Party may require the Dispute to be referred to The Director, All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi for amicable settlement. Upon such reference, both the Parties and the Director or his nominee shall meet at the earliest mutual convenience and in any event within 7 (seven) days of such reference to discuss and attempt to amicably resolve the dispute. If the dispute is of such reference to discuss and attempt to amicably resolve the dispute. If the Dispute is not amicably resolved within 7 (seven) days of such meeting, either Party may refer the Dispute to arbitration in accordance with the provisions given below.

27.2-Arbitration-

(a) Any Dispute which is not resolved amicably, as provided, shall be finally settled by binding arbitration under the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.

(b)**Place of Arbitration:** The place of arbitration shall be New Delhi.

(c) **Language** The request for arbitration, the answer to the request, the terms of reference, any written submissions, any orders and rulings shall be in English and, if oral hearings take place, English shall be the language to be used in the hearings.

(d)**Procedure** The procedure to be followed in the arbitration by the Arbitral Tribunal shall be in accordance with the Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996 and as may be decided by the Arbitral Tribunal.

(e) **Enforcement of Award:** Any decision or award resulting from arbitration shall be final and binding upon the Parties. The parties hereto hereby waive, to the extent permitted by Law, any rights to appeal or to review of such award by any Court or Tribunal. The Parties here to agree that the arbitral award may be enforced against the Parties to the arbitration proceedings or their assets wherever they may be found and that a judgment upon the arbitral award may be entered in any Court having jurisdiction thereof.

(g) **Performance during Arbitration:** Pending the submission of and / or decision on a dispute difference or claim or until the arbitral award is published the parties shall continue to perform all of their obligations under this Contract without prejudice to a final adjustment in accordance with such award.

28-INSPECTION OF DIESEL ENGINE AMBLANCE AT DESTINATION STATION

On receipt of the diesel engine ambulance at the place of delivery, the ambulance shall be jointly inspected by the Contractor/Bidder and the Purchaser for completeness and satisfactory condition of all equipment/components. Damages, defects and deficiencies, occurred during the transportation of the chassis to the destination, if any, shall be noted and the Contractor/Bidder shall be initiated for immediate rectifications.

29-PAYMENT TERMS

100% payment within 30 days from the date of satisfactory receipt of stores at consignee location.

30-WARRANTY
