Name of the Item: Purchase of accessories for wall mounted blood pressure instrument (cuffs, bulbs and tubing)

Specification of cuffs, corrugated tubings, bulbs and valves

Purchase of accessories for wall mounted blood pressure instrument (cuffs, bulbs and tubing)

- The accessories should be compatible with existing Hein/ACCOSON wall amounted blood pressure instrument.
- Corrugated tube: The tubing should be corrugated (telephone cord like) and at least 3 meters in length with connector between the corrugated tube and the cuff.
- Blood pressure cuff: The cuff along with its tubing should be latex free and its surface should be easily cleanable. The name of company should be mentioned on the cuff
- 4. Insufflation bulb: The insufflations bulb should be made of good quality material and should allow rapid insufflation.
- Pressure-release vale: The pressure release valve should permit precise release of
 pressure and also allow fast deflation. On releasing the valve, the air should come
 out rapidly without any need to press the cuff to take out residual air.
- 6. All the accessories should be CE European/ISI/FDA approved.

 Prices should be quoted SEPARATELY for corrugated tubing, B.P. cuff with its small tubing (to connect with corrugated tube), Insufflation bulb and Pressure release valve

TERMS & CONDITIONS:

- 1. The quotations should be addressed to 'Professor & Head, HOD Office, Department of Emergency Medicine, AIIMS, New Delhi-29' and sent by post/ courier by 10/12/2016 up to 5.00 P.M Quotations should be sealed in an envelope with the reference no. and item name clearly written on top of the envelop. [(i.e. L.T.E No.-03/Emergency Med./M&S/ 2016-17 (Non-Plan) quotation for the item/accessories for wall mounted blood pressure instrument (cuffs, bulbs and tubing))
- 2. The firm must be registered and having TIN no./ registration no. (Please mentioned TIN/ registration no. on the tender bids) or else the quotation will be REJECTED.
- 3. The bidder is required to submit bid in two parts viz
 - (a) Technical Bid in one envelope containing following information.
 - i. Technical descriptions of quoted model/s
 - ii. List of all consumables/accessories required to run the equipment
 - iii. Terms & conditions including warranty/CMC/Taxes etc.
 - iv. Original Catalogues of quoted model/s
 - v. Earnest Money Deposit
 - vi. All required affidavits/undertaking
 - vii. Principal company authorization letter

(b) Commercial bid in second envelope containing following information

- Offered price of quoted model/s
- ii. Price list of all consumables/spares/accessories required to run the equipment Both the envelopes containing bids should be packed in one sealed envelope.
- 4. The Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of Rs. 2000 in favour of 'Director, AIIMS, Delhi' in the form of Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt, Banker's Cheque or a Bank Guarantee in acceptable form from any of the Scheduled Banks should be enclosed with Technical bid. Without EMD the bid will be not considered and simultaneously rejected.
- 5. The offered make/brand should be mentioned on the bid. Relevant literature/original catalogue should be submitted along with the technical bid failing with item would not be considered.
- Quotation should be typed/ written in ink. No overwriting or erased entries should be there in the quotation. The rates should be valid for at least nine months.

- 7. VAT/Sales tax or any other kind of tax(s) must be separately mentioned against each item. In case no sales tax is chargeable, prices must be quoted as NET PRICE.
- 8. Warranty/Guarantee: All the item must be covered under 6 months comprehensive warranty from the date of Installation.

Undertakings:

- a) An undertaking should be enclosed with the technical bid stating 'that the firm has deposited the VAT/ SALES TAX to the VAT department of last period, and there is no outstanding of taxes pending against the firm'.
- b) The firm has to give a affidavit on non-judicial stamp paper that the firm has not been blacklisted in the past by any Institution, Government/Private.
- c) The firm has to give an affidavit on a non-judicial stamp paper that there is no vigilance FEMA/CBI case pending against the firm/supplier.
- d) The firm has to give an affidavit on a non-judicial stamp paper that the firm is not supplying the same item at lower rates quoted in the tender to any government organization or any other institution during past 1 year, as per FALL CLAUSE adhered by DGS&D and other government agencies.
- 9. Installation and training of equipment will be provided by the company at free of cost and no extra charges will be paid.
- 10. The firm must be able to supply the item at the mentioned place/location within stipulated time for supply after issuing the Supply Order.
- 11. The payment will be made electronically viz RTGS/NEFT after delivery and satisfactory installation of the item. The supplier firm has to provide the bank details on each page of bill for payment. The Institute will not issue C&D form against the order placed in Indian Rupees.
- 12. The Professor & Head of the Department reserves the right to cancel/reject full or any part of the rate enquiry which generally do not fulfil the conditions stipulated in the rate enquiry.
