1. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchasis preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local contex shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountar chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) o 2017 dated 04.06.2020. Only Class-I and Class-II Local suppliers as per MII order dated 4.6.2020 will be eligible to bio Non - Local suppliers as per MII order dated 04.06.2020 are not eligible to participate. However, eligible micro and sr enterprises will be allowed to participate .In case Buyer has selected Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprices in the bid, the same will get precedence over this clause.

2. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry o Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bic wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid fo supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer)of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY.

3. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has

relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which wo determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received / RA process.

4. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst first 50% of the technically qualified bidders arranged in the order prices from lowest to highest. Number of sellers eligible for participating in RA would be rounded off to next higher integer value if number of technically qualified bidders is odd (e.g. if 7 bids are technically qualified, then RA will be conducted amongst L-1 to L-4). In case number of technically qualified bidders are 2 or 3, RA will be between all with any elimination. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, then minimum N sellers would be taken to RA round. In case Primary products of only one OEM are left in contention for participation in RA based on lowest 50% b qualifying for RA, the number of sellers qualifying for RA would be increased to get at least products of one more OE (directly participated or through its reseller) if available. Further, if bid(s) of any seller(s) eligible for MSE preference are coming within price band of 15% of Non MSE L-1 or if bid of any seller(s) eligible for Make in India preference is / coming within price band of 20% of non MII L-1, then such MSE / Make in India seller shall also be allowed to particip the RA process.

1. 1. Comprehensive warranty:

Comprehensive warranty shall include preventive maintenance including calibration as per technical/ service /operational manual of the manufacturer, service charges and spares,. During the warranty period commencir from date of the successful completion of warranty period, Service personnel shall visit each consignee site as recommended in the manufacturerzkRs technical/ service /operational manual, at least once in six months. warranty shall not be including the consumables .Further there will be 98% uptime warranty during warranty period on 24 (hrs) X 7 (days) X 365 (days) basis, with penalty, to extend warranty period by double the downt period.

2. Service centres:

Details of Service outlets in India to render services for equipment to be furnished to buyer/consignees with complete address ,telephone numbers, e mails etc at time of making the supplies .It shall be the responsibility seller to ensure that authorized service centres are available to cater to the areas where supplies are made w reasonable distance from where the service calls can be handled .Details of toll free numbers for service call ¢ online registration of service requests also to be provided buyer/consignee at the time of supplies.

3. Source of supply:

It shall be responsibility of seller to provide Documents regarding source of equipments such as copy of Perfor invoice or any other documents to establish that the products supplied are manufactured by OEM indicated ar sourced from them .

4. Packing and Marking: Medical equipments being very delicate and sensitive packing for the goods shoul strong and durable enough to withstand transit including transhipment (if any), rough handling, open storage without any damage, deterioration etc. .The size, weights and volumes of the packing cases, remoteness of th final destination of the goods, availability or otherwise of transport and handling facilities at all points during t up to final destination,. Quality of packing, the manner of marking within & outside the packages and provisio accompanying documentation shall take in to consideration the type of medical equipments being supplied. T accessories shall be suitably labelled and packed .Each of the package shall be marked on three sides with indelible paint of proper quality: indicating contract number and date , brief description of goods including qui, .Packing list reference number , country of origin of goods and any other relevant details.

5. Spare Parts:

Seller shall provide materials, information etc. pertaining to spare parts manufactured and supplied by the OE shall be ensured that the required spares are available for purchase at least for 10 years from date of supplies case due to any reasons the production of the spare parts is discontinued sufficient advance notice should be to the buyer/consignee before such discontinuation to provide adequate time to purchase the required spare etc. Further, OEM and their service centres/dealers shall carry sufficient inventories to assure ex-stock supply consumables and spares for the equipments so that the same are available.

OEM or reseller shall always accord most favoured client status to the buyer/consignee and shall give the m competitive price for spares and consumables of its machines/equipments supplied

6. Installation, Training, Manuals:

Seller shall be responsible to carry out Installation & commissioning, Supervision and Demonstration of the go They shall provide required jigs and tools for assembly, minor civil works for the completion of the installation Training of ConsigneezkRs representatives for operating and maintaining the equipment and Supplying requir number of operation & maintenance manual for the goods. In case the category parameters are specifying an requirements regarding the installations , training and manuals the same shall also be applicable.

7. Electrical safety checking:

Sellers are required to make sure that they furnish the list of equipments for carrying out routine and prevent maintenance to buyer/consignee. They should make sure to periodically check the electrical safety aspects as BIS Safety Standards or equivalent. In case they do not have required equipment for such testing should ensu that the equipments checked for electrical safety compliance through labs with facilities for such checking du every preventive maintenance call.
